Racquetball League Rules

1. Eye guards are mandatory and must be worn.

Failure to wear eye guards for entire match will result in a forfeit.

- 2. Each player will be scheduled one match per week. You may play the match at any point that it is convenient for you and your opponent, and there is court availability. It is your responsibility to contact your opponent and set up a time for your match.
- 3. Court Reservations:
 - May be reserved M-Th 7am-10pm, F 7am-7pm, Sat. 9am-2pm, Sun. 2-5pm
 - You may call up to one week in advance to reserve these court times.
 - If that court is booked, you may call a day in advance for the public's court to reserve it for a league match, but please tell them that it's a league match or they may try to charge you when you come in to play the match.
- 4. Scores are reported into the Racquetball League binder at the front desk after your match.
- 5. Each match will consist of 2 games to 15 points, and a tiebreaker to 11 points if necessary. You only have to win by one, not two.
- 6. To determine whom serves first, find a way agreeable to both participants.
- 7. Hinders: Do not crowd each other. Allow room for your shots. If a hinder is called, play is done over. Court hinders require honesty and are also just done over.
- 8. Scoring:

5 points = winning in 2 consecutive games or forfeit

4 points = win in a tie-breaker

2 points = lose in a tie-breaker

1 point = lose in 2 consecutive games but score 20 or more total points.
